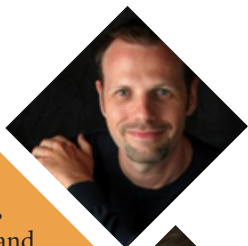
A Breath of French Air

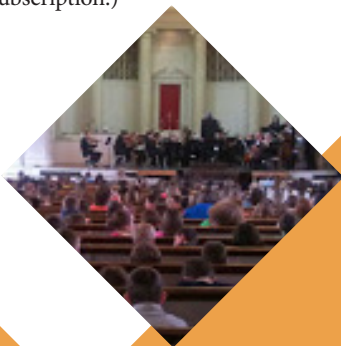
